## March Classes

Introduction to Lace Knitting Tuesdays, March 5 7PM-9PM This one night class will take the mystery out of knitting lace. It will cover the basic stitches, how to set your markers, and how to set and use a life line. With the mystery explained, lace knitting will be fast, easy and enjoyable. The class is \$15, and is limited to 6 students. You may bring your own needles (US 5-7) and worsted weight yarn, or buy them in the shop.

The Lace Scarf Tuesdays, March 12-26 7PM-9PM Put what you learned into practice by knitting a lace scarf. We'll walk you through the pattern and process using worsted weight yarn so the stitches are easy to see. This is a great "1<sup>st</sup>" project. The class is \$45 and is limited to 6 students. Materials are available in the shop.

Advanced Spinning Wednesdays, March 6-27 7PM-9PM If you have a wheel and know the basics, but aren't able to make a variety if types of yarn, this class is just heat you need. You'll learn the different techniques needed to produce a variety of yarn. We'll cover long and short draw, spinning short fibers, different plying techniques, spinning from the card and the fold, and learn how to duplicate commercial yarns. You'll also learn how to utilize the whorls and settings your of your wheel. The class is limited to 6 students. All students must have their own wheels. The class fee of \$90 includes all fiber needed for the class.

Domino Knitted Blanket Thursdays, March 7-28 7PM-9 PM Learn Domino Knitting in a evening. With one night of instruction and a 3 weeks of workshop time, you'll be on your way to completing a wool blanket. The class fee is only \$20. Materials are available for purchase in the shop. Limit 6 students.
